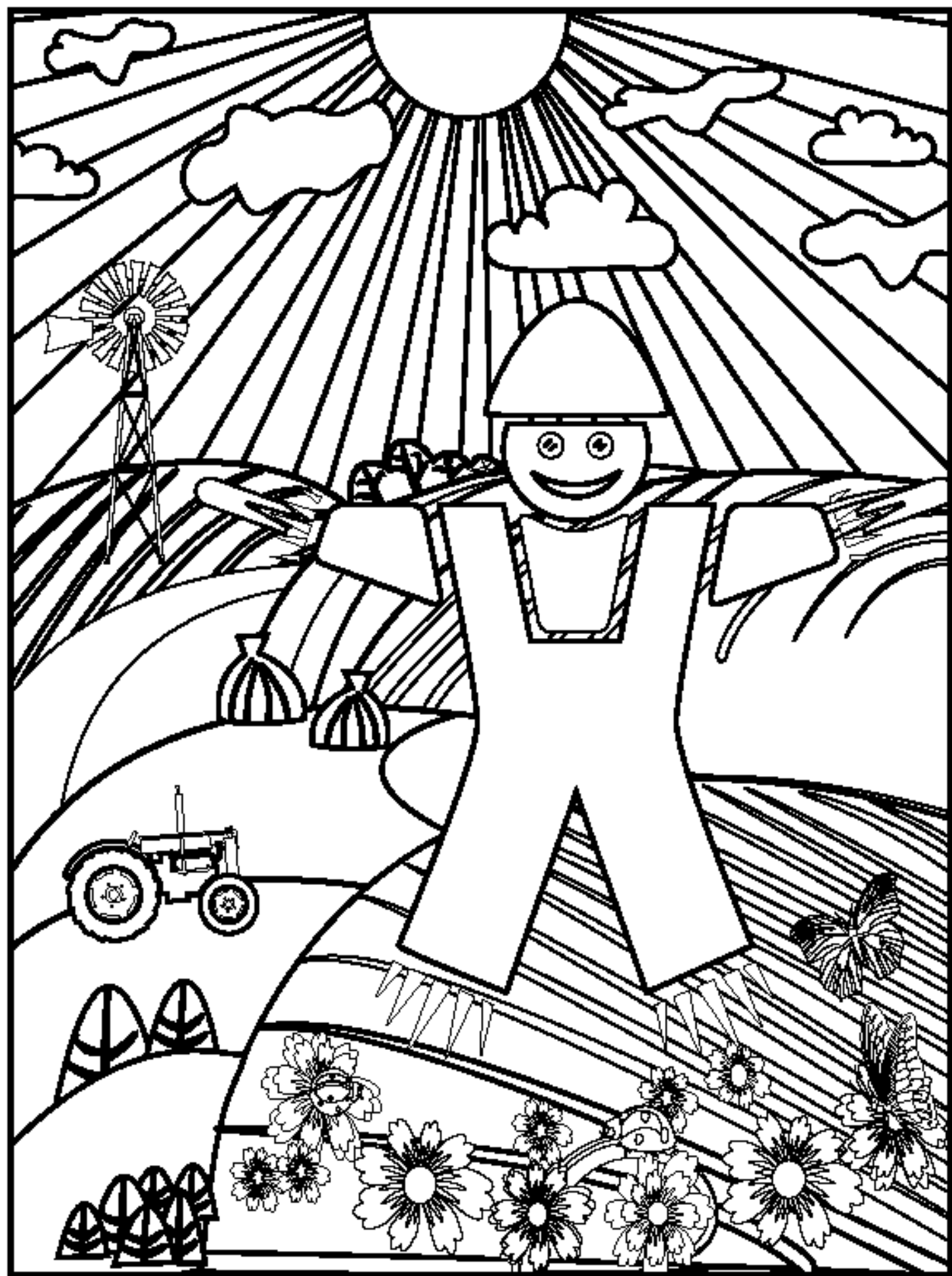
Over the past 4 weeks all the children have been working hard creating a design that can be used for a calendar or an I-Phone cover.
