NAPLAN

This week our children in Year 3 & 5 have been undertaking the NAPLAN testing program. I would like to remind all of our community that this test is a snapshot of a child's performance on just **one** day. Whilst often this assessment is accurate, it may not be truly indicative of your child's normal performance - events that may take place on any given day, e.g. unwell, missing pet etc., can have a significant impact on their performance. Undue pressure can also have an impact. We do have to treat it as a test, but we also want the children to not react poorly to this unique situation.

CURRICULUM DAY—NUMERACY

On Monday we held a combined Curriculum Day with other PLC schools on Numeracy. In excess of 220 teachers attended our school on the day and participated in workshops with 7 experts in the field of mathematics. Our key speaker was George Booker, who has written books published around the world. These books guide teachers as to the correct process for teaching numeracy and is used at all Universities. We were extremely fortunate to have George at our school.
