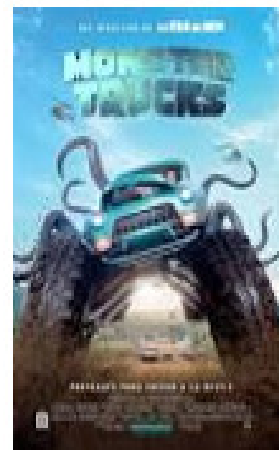

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION **DO YOU HAVE A CURRENT CONCESSION CARD?** CAMPS, SPORT & EXCURSION FUND

The CSEF is provided by the Victorian Government to assist eligible families to help cover the cost of school excursions, camps and sporting activities.

If you hold a valid concession card or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible for this CSEF payment. The allowance will be paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions or sporting activities.

The annual CSEF amount per student is \$125 for Primary School students.

**How to apply:** Contact the school administration office to obtain a CSEF application form or print one from the school website.

If you received CSEF in 2016, you are still required to complete a new application form.

Please note: Funds cannot be allocated to your account and used for upcoming activities until you have completed the form and eligibility has been confirmed.
