Hi, I'm Indi Amoruso (6BN) and I'm Molly Potter (6CH) and this year we're the 2018 Performing Arts Captains. We are the student representatives for our Performing Arts teachers Miss Davies and Ms Chappell.

TERM ONE

Over the past Term all year levels have participated in various drama and dance activities. Preps have experimented with puppets, they have focused on changing their voices to suit the puppets as well as completing many fun and exciting drama and dancing games! Grade ones and twos have also been using the puppets but to be acting out a story with the puppets as the characters for 'Mr Gumpy's Day Out'!

Year levels three and four all participated in script reading on the project to make a B4W, silent, short film! WE WANT OUR STUDENTS TO TELL US WHAT THEY THINK!

We value student voice as a means to improving student engagement, wellbeing and quality instruction and are conducting a survey to find out what your child thinks of our school. The Attitudes to School Survey is an annual student survey offered by the Department of Education and Training to assist schools in gaining an understanding of students' perceptions and experience of school. Our school will use the survey results to plan programs and activities to improve your child's schooling experience.

Students from Year 4 to 6 at our school will participate in the survey. Your child will complete the survey online during school hours using a purpose built secure online survey tool. It is important to note that we are not in any way "testing" your child. Your child has the right to refuse or withdraw from the survey at any point before, during, or after completion of the survey.

Your child will be provided with a unique login to complete the survey. The student login is an assigned identifier that may be used to link data for statistical and research purposes only. All responses to the survey are kept anonymous in the response file. Personal identification data will not be recorded in the survey response file. This ensures that the confidentiality of your child's responses is protected at all times.

This year the Attitudes to School survey will be conducted at our school over the period Monday 23 April to Friday 1 June. The survey only takes 20 minutes to complete and occurs during your child's Digital Technology class time.

The survey results will be reported back to the school before the end of term 2. All survey data that is made available in reports are for groups of students only so that no individual student can be identified. Data suppression rules are used for schools with low student numbers per year level.

Nude Food Competition

Dear Parents,

As you would be aware the Pearcedale Primary School Community has been putting a lot of effort into becoming a more sustainable school. Already this year we have introduced a recycling and composting program, started a student sustainability team and participated in Clean-Up Australia day.

To further improve the sustainability of our school we are now introducing a nude food competition. For those of you who are unsure what 'nude food' is, it is essentially using less packaging in our school lunches. This could include using plastic containers, reusable bags or lunchboxes with compartments for different types of foods instead of glad wrap, foil and other food packaging. All of these mean that we are using less rubbish at Pearcedale but also in our everyday lives. For nude food ideas please check the newsletter weekly.

The nude food competition will take place every Tuesday during Term 2, so the Student Sustainability Team asks that you and your children try to pack lunches on these days that require little or no packaging. At the end of each week the class that has the lowest total pieces of rubbish on Tuesdays will be the winners. The winning grade will also go in the running for a prize at the end of the term.

This examines the impact of litter on the environment and explores practical means for reducing and minimising the amount of litter produced by the school.

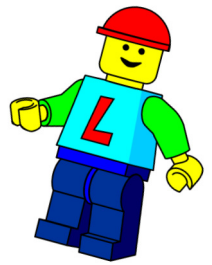
