SANDPIT / PLAYGROUND REFURBISHMENT

A huge thank you to everyone involved in the construction of the new sandpit which has proven to be a very popular new play area. The work undertaken was coordinated by Corbin Ellis, one of our parents. I would like to thank Corbin and his company SEBS for their wonderful generosity. Two parents, Garth Brown and Mark Howell also donated their time and expertise.



Three of our students Darcy E, Taelan B and Jamie A were also fantastic apprentices! Of course, Nev Howlett was also heavily involved in the construction!!

School Council has approved the purchase of two new shade sail structures which will cover the middle and rear adventure playgrounds. This is the result of the fine efforts of our school community at our recent Carnival, which raised over \$40,000 and careful financial planning by our Business Manager, Lisa Stanborough.

We have also ordered the construction of additional playground equipment for the hall playground!

Our new turf area comprising of a running track, soccer oval and ball sport areas should commence next Wednesday. A bit later than we had planned, but it will be worth all the wait when it is completed and children are playing happily on these areas. Nearly \$340,000 will be spent in total for the playground refurbishment and upgrade. The majority of this money has been saved from the recent Carnivals and accumulated to enable us to complete this massive redevelopment. Thank you to the whole community!

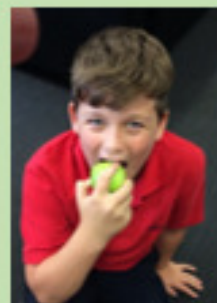

CONVEYANCE ALLOWANCE - 2018

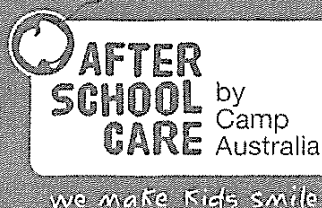
Students who meet the Department of Education and Early Childhood Development's criteria are able to claim a conveyance allowance to assist with their travel costs to school by private car.

The main criteria for student eligibility are:

- **You must live more than 4.8km from Pearcedale Primary School and**
- **Pearcedale Primary School is the closest government school to your residential address.**

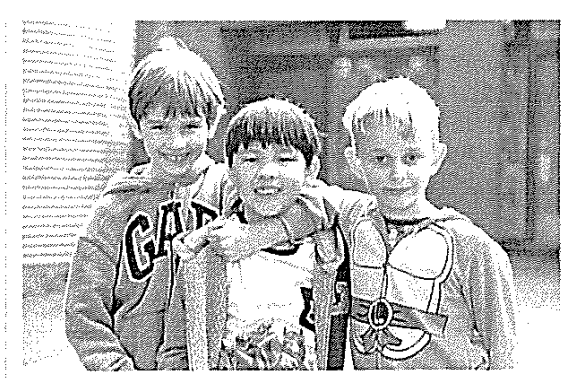

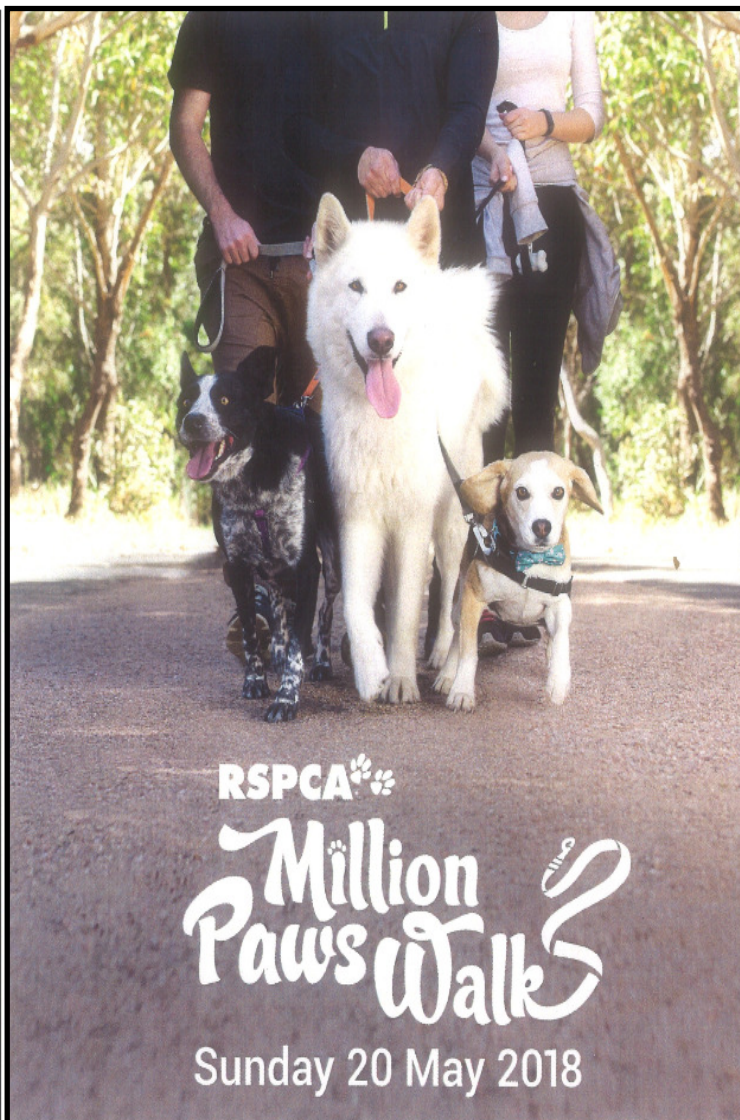
